

IMPACT OF NHPRC IN ALABAMA

The National Historical Publications and Records Commission (NHPRC) promotes the preservation and use of America's documentary heritage essential to understanding our democracy, history, and culture. Since 1964, the NHPRC has awarded \$163 million to 4,200 projects in all 50 states and special jurisdictions.

Total Cost of Projects supported by NHPRC in Alabama:

\$879,820 Direct Federal Grants

Projects of Special Value to the State of Alabama:

The NHPRC has played a unique role in supporting historical Records projects of special value to Alabama including...

Birmingham Public Library -- to establish a records management/archives program for the City of Birmingham and to provide a model for other large cities in Alabama.

Local records in Alabama – support to help organize, preserve, manage, and make accessible local records throughout the state.

University of South Alabama -- to preserve and make available negatives from the Erik Overbey Collection, a large commercial photograph collection documenting the history of Mobile since the 1880s.

Alabama Space and Rocket Center -- for consultation in planning an archival program. The center's holdings include papers of Wernher von Braun and others who were instrumental in the development of rocketry from the beginning of space flight to the late 1970s.
